SCHOOL UNIFORM RULES & CODE

- 1. Students are expected to present themselves neatly and in full uniform at all times.
- 2. Students not in full Uniform should report to their Year Head before 8.50am, where an alternative uniform item will be supplied.
- 3. Non uniform items will be confiscated. Items of Uniform must be replaced when outgrown or worn out.
- 4. Uniform Tracksuit and Sports Shoes to be worn for PE and Games only.
- 5. Make-up is not allowed for students from First Year to Fifth Year inclusive. Leaving Cert students may wear discreet make-up. Students will be asked to remove make-up and given wipes to do so.
- 6. All types of body piercing, other than small stud earrings are not allowed under Health & Safety.
- 7. Inappropriate hairstyles and extreme hair colours are prohibited. Hairstyles must be neat and tidy. Hair accessories must be discrete and acceptable to Management.
- 8. First offence, verbal warning. Repeated infringements of the Uniform Code will be treated as a serious breach of discipline and will be dealt with accordingly.
